According to the Neighbourhood Planning referendums regulations 2012, once votes have been counted there will be a public notice giving:

- the results of the referendum
- the number of ballot papers counted
- the total number of votes counted for each answer
- the number of rejected ballot papers

Leeds City Council Publish the results on their website. We are sure the result will be published on social media once it is known. Our city councillors will be informed of the result. GNPF will notify members and also publish the result on our website.
