Car Park Review

This is a survey of car parking in Garforth, carried out on 30 November 2017 at the car parks on Barleyhill Road and behind Barclays Bank.

Cars parked in the two car parks were reviewed three times during the day at approximately 9:00, 12:00 and 15:00 to establish the number of spaces taken up as long stay parking, and hence see how many were left available for short stay shoppers etc.

The following results were found for the total of 175 spaces in both car parks.

82 Spaces were taken up by vehicles which parked before 9:00 and were still there at 15:00 (47%)

28 Spaces were taken up by vehicles which parked before 9:00 and were still there at 12:00, although they had left by 15:00 (16%)

12 Spaces were taken up by vehicles which parked after 9:00 but before 12:00 and which were still there at 15:00 (7%)


10 Spaces were designated for disabled use, and 1 for motorbikes

This left just **42** spaces (24%) used for short-stay parking.

It was also noted during the carrying out of the survey that there was a fairly constant stream of traffic entering and then leaving the car parks having found no available spaces.

The layouts of the car parks, showing the spaces occupied as long and short stay parking are set out below.
